

BEHAVIOR STANDARDS

Classroom behavior standards are based on respect for the catechist, the other students, and for the learning atmosphere in the room and the building. This creates a safe social environment for students.

In the event that any student is unable to maintain the required atmosphere of respect, separate arrangements will be made available for his/her religious education *outside* the classroom. (e.g. tutor, time out, individual work).
